Holistic – with Agile, Programme, Portfolio Extensions & powerful Mindsets



**Common** – Same vocabulary for crossinstitutional and crossregional initiatives



Lean (not simplistic) – which ensures easy adoption, two-level tailoring & roll-out

### PM<sup>2</sup> as a Solution in the EIF Toolbox




In 2021, PM² is included as a solution on the <u>European</u>

Interoperability Framework Toolbox, a guidance for national public administrations to equip them with the tools necessary to align their National Interoperability Frameworks (NIFs) with the European Interoperability Framework (EIF) in order to promote interoperability at national and European level.





## PM<sup>2</sup> as Essential Knowledge at ESCO



In 2022, PM² is classified as **Essential Project Management Knowledge** in ESCO, the European multilingual classification of Skills, Competences and Occupations.

ESCO works as a dictionary, describing, identifying, and classifying professional occupations and skills relevant for the EU labour market and education and training. ESCO <u>Project Manager</u> & <u>Project Support Officer</u> descriptions are modelled against those of PM<sup>2</sup>.


